## MORNING MISSION


Dear Friend,

When I got up this morning at 4:30am to make coffee and pray, it was 7 degrees below zero outside... with 20 inches of snow on the ground!

I got down on my knees and prayed, "Lord, thank you for a warm bed and a warm house to wake up in this morning. I know most of the people who will come to Target Dayton this morning are without these blessings. Some are struggling to keep from freezing to death in a parking garage or abandoned house right now."

I prayed, "And thank you for this beautiful quiet place for me to spend time in prayer with you this morning. I know most of the people who will come to Target Dayton this morning, will wake up in a crowded homeless shelter with constant noise, fights and chaos. They have no peace or quiet."

I prayed, "And Lord, thank you for your presence in my life this morning... you mean everything to me! I know most of the people who will come to Target Dayton this morning are still alone in the darkness without you. And most are so beaten up... so broken... so discouraged... they have given up all hope." [continued >](#)





And I cried over them, as I often do, as I felt Jesus' love for them in my heart. I know that He deeply loves each one of them. He feels their suffering and suffers with them. He sees their tears and cries over them. He longs to relieve their suffering and dry their tears.

I believe that's why Jesus said, *"Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me."* (Matthew 25:40). That means when we relieve the suffering of the poorest and the least, whom He loves, His joy knows no bounds! And that's what Target Dayton is all about. We're here to help *"the least of these brothers of mine"* for Jesus.

Men and women whose spirits have been crushed by sin, poverty, addiction and homelessness began flooding in. Soon our building became crowded with people without a home, without a job, and without a dollar. People all alone in the world with no one who cares. Some had ragged clothes and needed a shower. All were hungry, cold, harassed, and weary... and grateful for a freshly brewed cup of hot coffee to drink and a warm place to sit and rest.

After everyone had a chance to have a cup of coffee and warm up, we invited *"the least of these brothers of mine"* into the sanctuary for our morning worship service. And during wor-

I prayed, "Lord Jesus, please use all of us at Target Dayton this morning to show them your love and lead them to you. Please help us to put ourselves in their shoes, and love them and treat them the way you would."

Then at 7:30am this morning, we opened our doors and invited *"the least of these brothers of mine"* who were out in the cold all night, into our warm ministry building. And our busses and shuttles began bringing many more

of *"the least of these brothers of mine"* from the homeless shelters. We welcomed each person

worship and the preaching of the gospel, hearts began to soften. Hands lifted. Tears fell. And some of "*the least of these*" surrendered their hearts to Jesus! They came through our doors discouraged and feeling like giving up... and left with new faith and strength to go on. They came without hope and without God... and left with Jesus! And His joy knows no bounds!
